### AgrAbility of Wisconsin Annual Advisory Council Meeting

AgrAbility of Wisconsin and Easter Seals FARM Program holds an annual meeting for members of the AAW Advisory Council. During this meeting, members are introduced to a former client and have the opportunity to hear about his or her story. They also receive information about the program's year in review regarding client demographics and other statistics. Twenty-three members were in attendance this year and had the opportunity to discuss and suggest activities and ideas to increase the success of the AgrAbility project in Wisconsin.

According to the demographic information presented to members, AgrAbility is actively working with 226 clients and have closed 97 client cases since April 15, 2005. In 2004-05, AAW closed 85 client cases and of these cases, 85% were male and 14% were female with 70% of the total clients being dairy farmers. The demographic numbers remain similar each grant year with dairy dominating and orthopedic impairments reported as the leading disability of Wisconsin farmers.
